83RD UNITED STATES JUNIOR CHAMBER PRESIDENT MICHAEL F. FALLER WILL JOIN HAWAII JAYCEES AT ITS THRID TRIMESTER CONVENTION

83rd United States Junior Chamber President Michael F. Faller will be a special guest at the Hawaii Jaycees first trimester convention, which will take place at the Makaha Resort Golf Club in Waianae from April 29 to May 1.

Mr. Faller, who served as President of the United States Junior Chamber in 2003, will also be joining Hawaii Jaycee members, along with members of the Lualualei and Waianae Lions at a joint beach clean up project being held at Pokai Bay beach park in Waianae on April 30th starting at 2:30 pm. Mr. Faller will be the guest speaker at the convention's dinner awards banquet also held on Saturday starting at 6:30 pm at the Makaha Resort.

Michael F. Faller has been a member of The United States Junior Chamber since March 1988. He served as the 83rd National President for the year 2003.

Mr. Faller is a 1987 graduate of Dickinson State University with a Bachelor of Science in Business Administration. He joined the Dickinson, North Dakota Jaycees and began his Jaycee career as Chapter Treasurer. In 1989, he served as Management Development Vice President for the chapter and in May of 1989 he became Chapter President, finishing in sixth place out of 54 chapters in the North Dakota State Parade of Chapters.

In 1990, Mr. Faller served as District Director and received a Blue Chip Certificate. In 1991 he served as the state's Management Development Vice President and received the North Dakota Roughrider Award, the highest award a North Dakota Jaycee can achieve.

In 1993, Mr. Faller became assistant Outstanding Young Farmer Program Manager and then served as State OYF Program Manager from 1994 through 1996. He was named one of the top three Program Managers in the nation twice and received his 10th Degree during that time.

Mr. Faller served as the 66th State President of the North Dakota Jaycees in 2000, finishing sixth in the National Parade of States as well as receiving the Allen Whitfield Memorial Award. Mike was also awarded with JCI Senator Number 61847.

In 2002, Mr. Faller served as National Vice President assigned to the states of Illinois, Florida, North Dakota, Oklahoma, and Delaware and was cross-assigned to Minnesota.

Now a member of the Mandan and Greater Grand Forks Jaycees in North Dakota, Mr. Faller has also been involved in the Dickinson Elks for 17 years, the Knights of Columbus for 15 years and Scoutmaster for Troup 130 in Grand Forks for two years.

Mike, his wife Kelly, and their three children Michael, Kathryn, and Tanner, resides in Grand Forks, North Dakota, where Mr. Faller is employed as a sales representative for Congress Inc.
