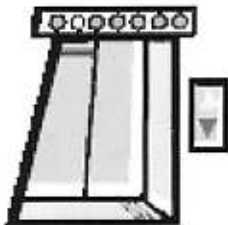
Module 6 - July 14th – Give Me a “J” Give Me a “C”! : Nourishing the team’s spirit
